Plot:

Hello Kitty has big dreams about going to the city and becoming a singer. Although her family want to stay in their small town, Hello Kitty tries out at Alley Cat Records. Sylvester the Cat is the company's executive director. He isn't convinced that she has the talent the record label wants, so he sends her to a vocal coach and the company's critics. Hello Kitty's inner critics have a lot to say on the matter, but through the support of her friends she continues her fight to become a star.

Scene 1:

Hello Kitty's home

Hello Kitty:

I've decided, I want to
go to New York Kitty,
and be a professional
singer.

Gizabella:

Oh! The city is so
crowded and full of bad
cats. I would be so
worried.

Lil Bub:

You won't let me go to
the city.

Tom:

Why can't you stay here
and sing at the Meow
Club.

Hello Kitty:

My big city dreams
can't happen if I stay in
this small town. I have
a meeting tomorrow
with a music producer.

Scene 2:

Alley Cat Records in the
city, Sylvester's office

Sylvester:

Make sure you get my lunch order right. And send a tweet to Tweety Bird, that's she's always welcome to stop by for lunch.

Talking on the phone

Hello Kitty:

I'm so nervous. I hope I
am good enough for
Sylvester to sign me at
Alley Cat Records.

Grumpy Cat:

You should have stayed
in your small town. This
is a waste of time.

Puss N Boot:

I disagree! You have an amazing meow. They will love you. Now go in and FIGHT!

Hello Kitty:

Thank you for seeeing
me.

Sylvester:

Hurry up and start
singing, my lunch is on
the way.

Scene 5:

Discouraged, Hello Kitty meets with her friends at Catnip Garden in attempts to cheer her up.

Ms. Norris:

Hello Kitty. How did
your audition go?

Hello Kitty:

I felt like I had everything going for me at first, but they asked me to come back and try again.

Mr. Bigglesworth:

Hello...Don't sweat it,
you are the best singer,
baby! Your meow is
smashing!

Hello Kitty:

Now I am nervous that I
don't have what it
takes.

Ms. Norris:

You just have to believe in yourself. Things don't always come easy for some cats, but don't give up.

Hello Kitty:

Thank you both for your support. I can always count on you to pick me up when I've fallen out of a tree.

Mr. Bigglesworth:
